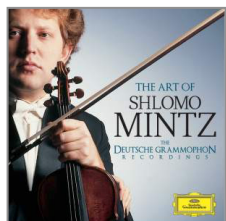


Long Life Career | Violinist, violist and conductor ***Shlomo Mintz celebrates his 60th birthday on Monday, October 30, 2017.*** Throughout his long life career, critics, colleagues and audiences regard Shlomo Mintz as one of the foremost violinists of our time, esteemed for his impeccable musicianship, stylistic versatility and commanding technique alike. Since then he is a celebrated guest with orchestras and conductors on the international music scene and he continues enchanting the audiences.

Born in Moscow in 1957, Mintz immigrated to Israel with his family two years later, where he studied violin with Ilona Feher. At the age of 11, he Philharmonic Orchestra and at the Carnegie Hall with the Pittsburgh patronage of Isaac Stern. He began Juilliard School of Music in New major European tour with famous Giuliani, Antal Dorati and Eugene Deutsche Grammophon.

Composer and Educator | Mintz recently started to compose for orchestra and chamber music. His **"anthem to an unknown nation"** was premiered last June in Budapest (Vigadó Grand Hall) and in August with the Cameristi della Scala in Crans-Montana (CH), where he presides the Crans-Montana Classics Masterclass. *"I am eager to help younger generations to carry the flag of classical and other music"*, emphasizes Mintz, *"I feel blessed to be involved in that process with all humans"*.
